Joe Nunn Award

Joe Nunn's family was instrumental in building the early Saanich school district, and Joe worked for many years in SD 63 as a custodian.

This \$1000 award will be given annually to three eligible applicants. The award is open to all students, but preference will be given to those whose parents or guardians are current or past members of CUPE Local 441.

Eligibility requirements:

- 1. Preference is given to students in SD 63 and who are in some way related to or associated with a past or present member of CUPE 441.**
- 2. Students must have met all entry requirements and have been accepted by a recognized post-secondary educational institution (university, trades, vocational or college). This is in the spirit of boosting our unionised workforce.**
- 3. Applicants will submit a transcript of the current year's grades and a short paragraph outlining their educational and vocational plans.**
- 4. Candidates who submit proof of being placed on a waiting list for their program may be awarded the scholarship. They will have up to two years to submit proof of acceptance by providing copies of receipts of registration.**
- 5. Application deadline is April 30 each year.**
